## Spiritual and religious care

Being in hospital can be a lonely and unsettling experience. People may value the opportunity to talk with someone about what's happening to them and how they feel about the changes they are facing. Sometimes people also appreciate support when they wish to give thanks or celebrate something special. We provide a wide range of care, support, and practical advice. We are also a resource for responding to diverse religious and cultural issues and needs.

#### We offer

- Support for patients, relatives and friends, and staff. We are here for all; you do not need to follow a particular religion to contact us
- Time and space to explore thoughts, feelings or concerns
- Religious care through reflection, prayer, reading of scriptures or sharing the sacraments
- Scriptures from various religious traditions, prayer books and cards
- Help to enable people to practise their faith within the hospital setting
- Services for special occasions such as Christmas Carol Services, our annual Time for Remembering and Celebrate a Life events (further details regarding Celebrate a Life events are available from the Fundraising team)
- Prayer and blessing following marriage or civil partnership
- Support and prayers at end-of-life

## The chaplains
