Guide for patients

What is Treatment Monitor?

Treatment Monitor is a secure online service that helps your care team to monitor your symptoms from the comfort of your own home. This is done through questionnaires and completing tasks about your symptoms, physical health and quality of life. You can complete the questionnaires and tasks in your MyMarsden account using your mobile, tablet, or computer.

Your care team will review your answers, helping them better understand how you're feeling and any concerns you may have about your treatment or wider health. By completing Treatment Monitor, your healthcare team will be able to keep track of your health regularly to help make your clinic visits more focused and productive, while also ensuring you receive timely advice on symptom management.

Getting started using Treatment Monitor

If you are eligible your care team will sign you up to Treatment Monitor and you will receive questionnaires and tasks to complete through the MyMarsden patient portal. Please complete these as accurately and honestly as possible so your care team has a full understanding of how you are feeling. Please use the guide below to help you understand what to expect from using Treatment Monitor.

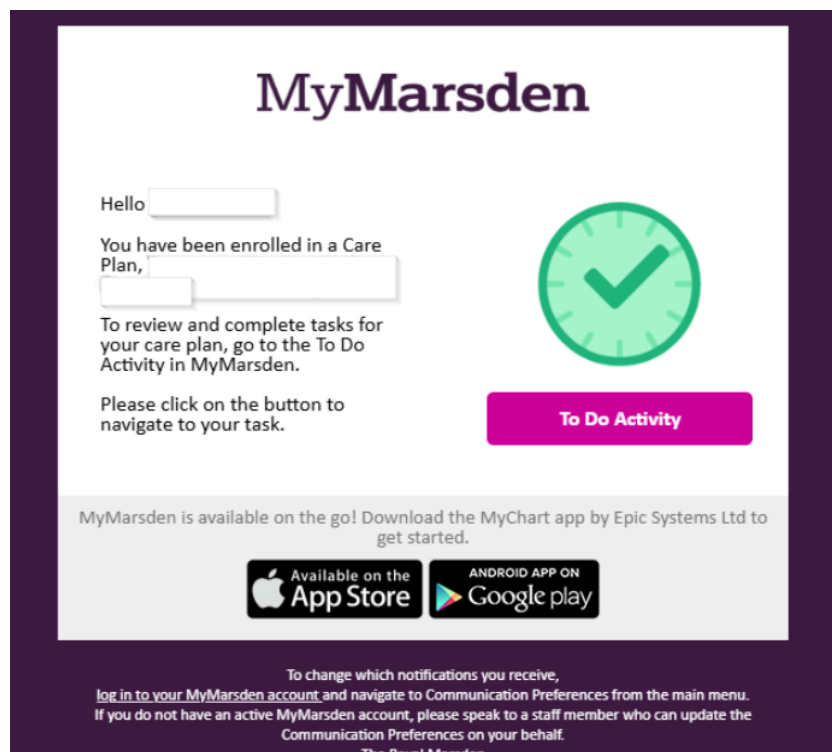
Completing Your Tasks in MyMarsden

Once you are enrolled onto Treatment Monitor, you will receive an automated email to inform you that you are on the Treatment Monitor Care Plan.

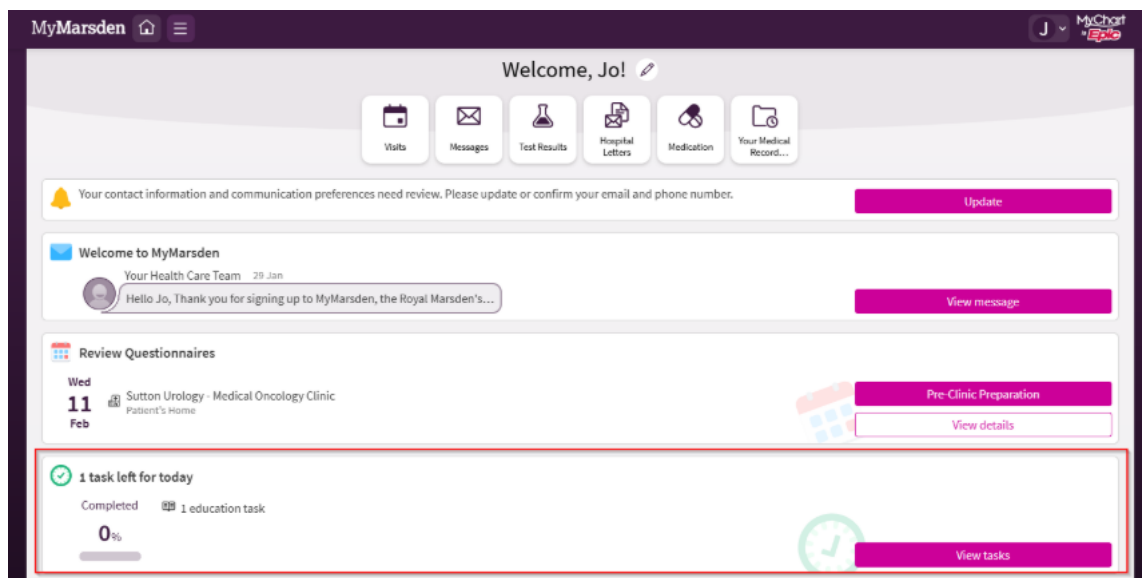


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When you log into MyMarsden, you will also see a notification on your home feed to inform you when you have outstanding tasks to complete.

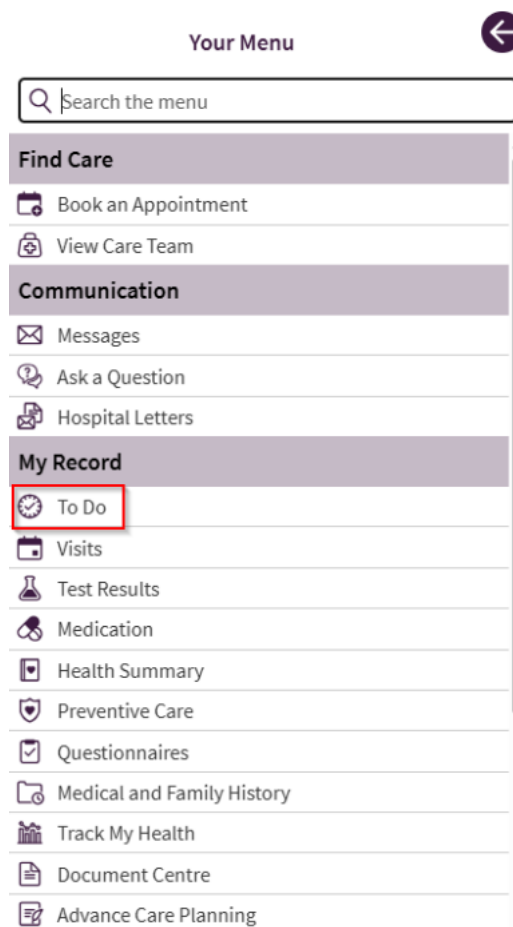


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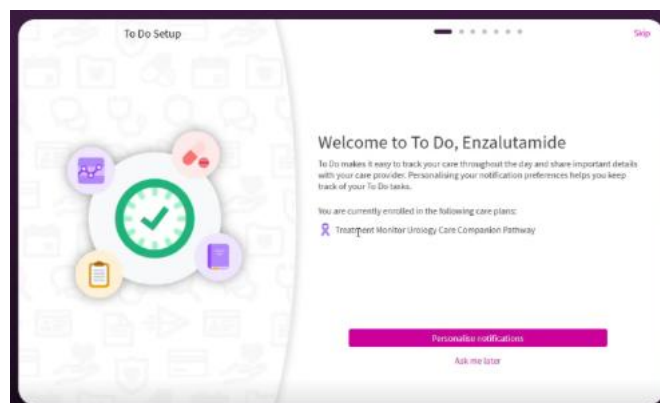


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Clicking on “View tasks” will take you to your “To do” activities in MyMarsden. You can also access this activity at any time from the main menu (three lines at the top left of the site/app).



The first time you click into the “To do” activity you will be prompted to select your preferences on how you receive notifications when tasks are available for you to complete.



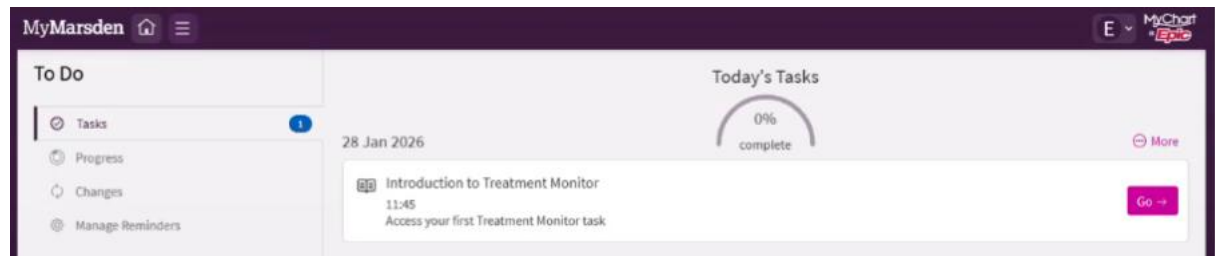
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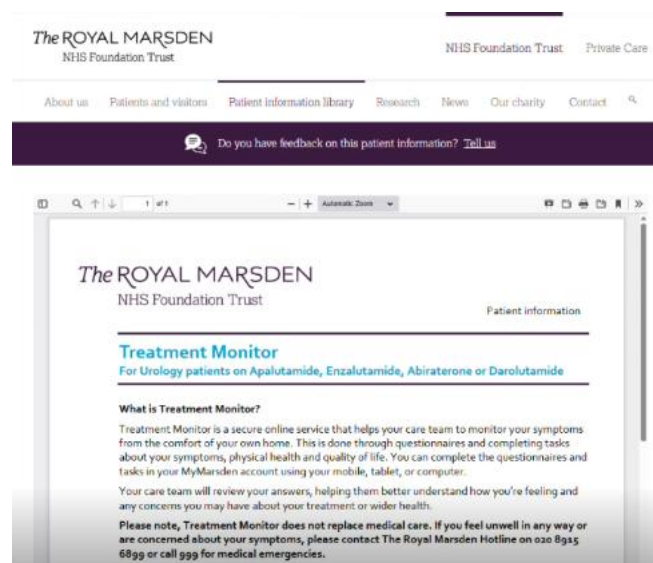
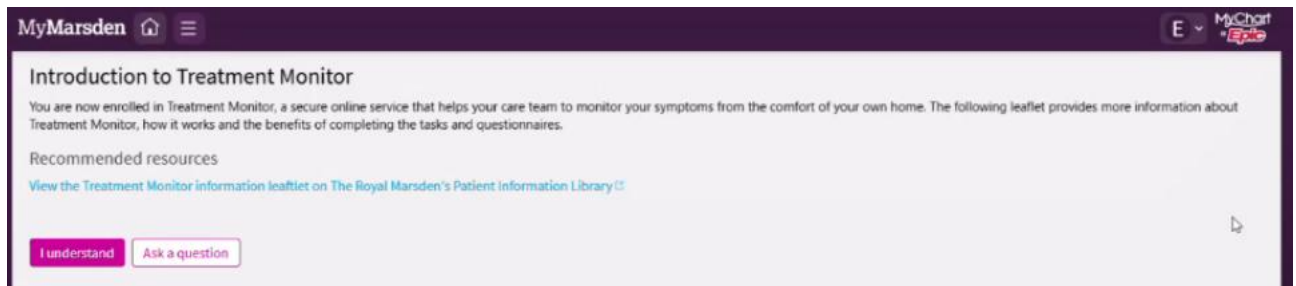
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To Do Activity

You will see any tasks you have available to complete in the “To do” menu (as explained above).



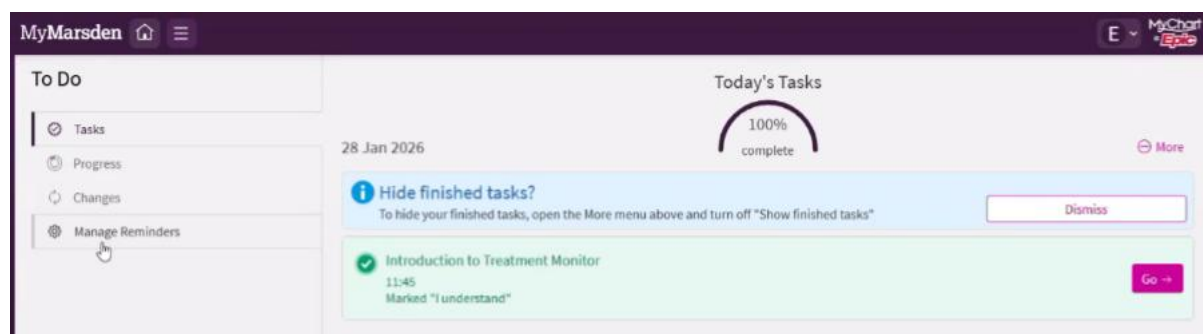
To open the task, click on the “Go” button. Please click on the blue writing to open any additional links.



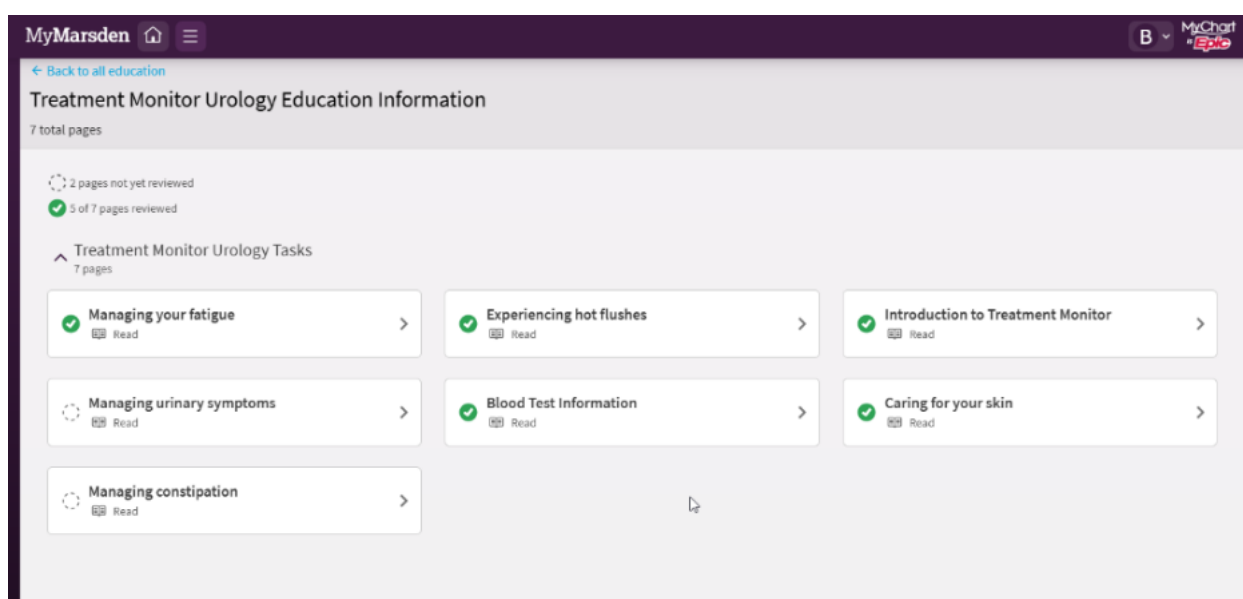
Once you have accessed the information, clicking “I understand” will complete the task. The task will turn green once it is complete. You also have the option to hide your finished tasks if you wish.



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If you would like to access your previous education resources, you can do so by navigating to the “Education” tab in the main menu (three lines in the top left).



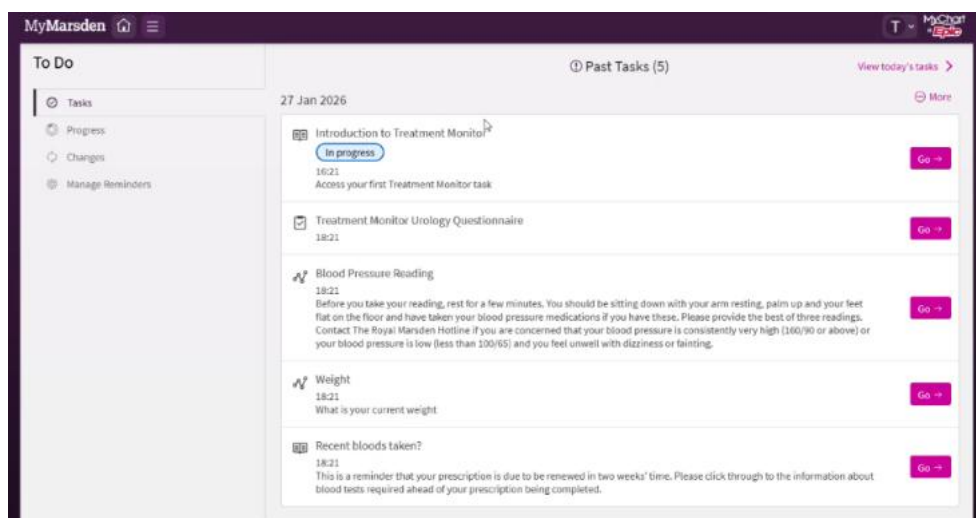
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Questionnaire and Additional Tasks

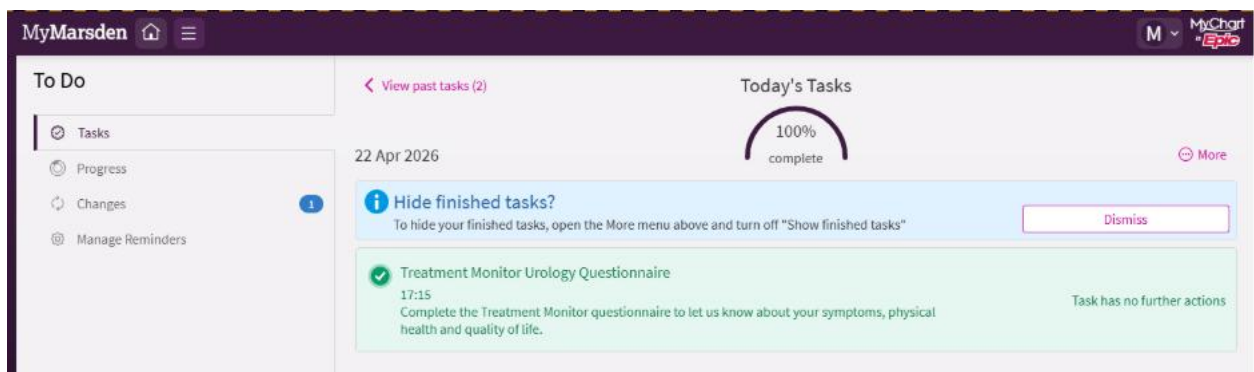
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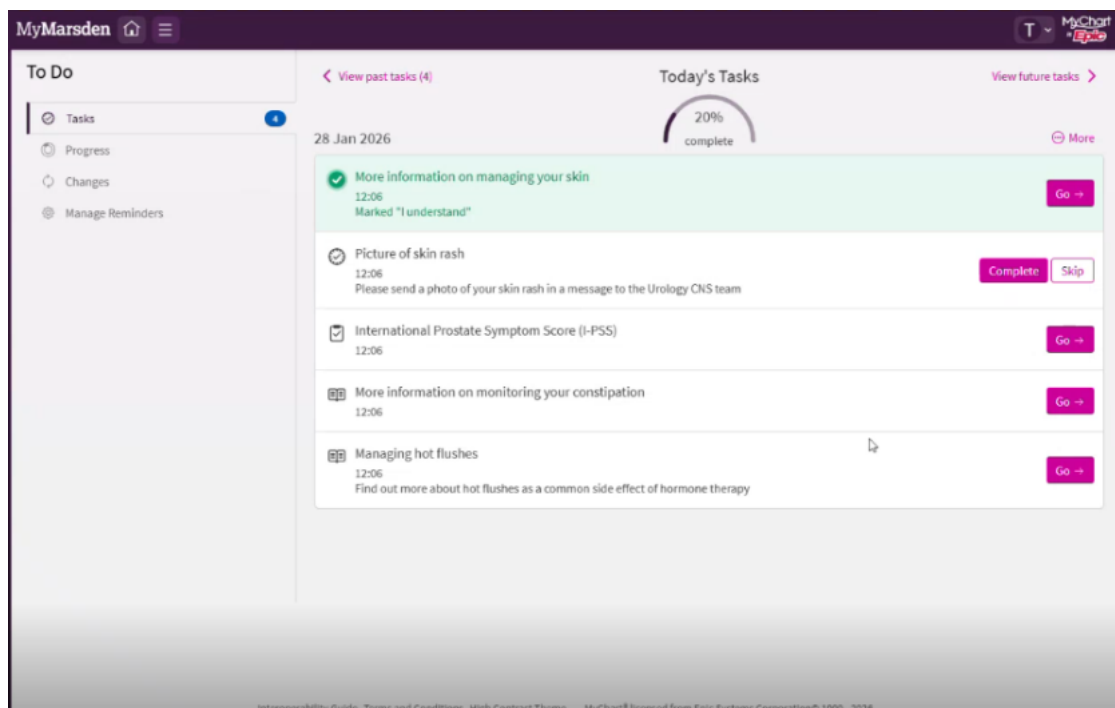
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The Questionnaire Task will turn green once the questionnaire has been submitted.
